

Residential Trips

All children have the opportunity to attend two residential trips during their time in KS2. One in either Year 3 or Year 4 and one in either Year 5 or Year 6.

These trips are arranged on a 2 year cycle to reflect the ages and development of the children and affordability for parents and carers. The costs of residential trips are subsidised by the school as approved by the Governing Body.

We select the locations and venues for our residential trips to provide a wide and varied range of learning and social development experiences for our children.
