The children will be listening to a story written and read by Dame Carol Ann Duffy. She is a Scottish poet and playwright. In addition, she is Professor of Contemporary Poetry at Manchester Metropolitan University and was appointed Britain's Poet Laureate in May 2009.



After the reading, we have been fortunate enough to have organised a short tour of Lincoln University where we will be able to eat our lunch. We will then walk over to the Collection Museum which houses artefacts from the Stone Age right through to the Romans, Anglo-Saxons and Vikings. A highlight for Year 6 will certainly be the Lincoln Plesiosaur!



We will be travelling by coach, leaving school promptly at 9.00am. For the return journey, we will be leaving the Collection Museum at 3pm. We should therefore be arriving back at school around 4pm.

School uniform will be worn and a packed lunch is required. Your child needs sensible shoes to walk from the University to the Museum and a warm coat.
