Y3 visit to The Collection, Lincoln- Wednesday 15th June 2016



Dear Parents,

I am delighted to advise you that year 3 will be visiting The Collection in Lincoln as a spark for our new Creative Curriculum topic, Predators! During the visit, we will take part in a prehistoric day which covers everything from the Ice Age up to right through to the coming of the Romans. We will take part in a dig where the children will get to excavate real and replica prehistoric items. They will get to do a play that shows them how mankind adapted from an Ice Age hunter gatherer to becoming a farmer. They will also get a guided tour of the gallery where they can handle real and replica items as well as being shown how things were made.

This visit will take place during the school day and we will be leaving at approximately 9.00am. The experience finishes at 2.30pm, so we will be back at school for approximately 3.30pm. Please make sure that there is an adult on the playground at the normal place for this time. If we are any later, you will be informed by school.

Snack and lunch

We will be having a packed lunch in the designated eating areas of The Collection. Any child that has usually has a school meal will have a packed lunch provided and we will take this with us. We will also be taking the children's water bottles and a mid-morning snack with us.

Cost & Permission
