Further to my recent letter, this is a reminder that the Year 6 SAT week takes place next week from Monday 11<sup>th</sup> May to Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> of May 2015. The timetable for the week is:

Date	Level 3 -5 Tests	Level 6 Tests
Monday 11 May	English reading	English reading
Tuesday 12 May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling test	No level 6 tests timetabled
Wednesday 13 May	Mental mathematics test; mathematics Paper 1	No level 6 tests timetabled
Thursday 14 May	Mathematics Paper 2	Mathematics Paper 1; mathematics Paper 2

These tests are extremely important and your child should be in school every day. The tests are timetabled throughout the day with some starting promptly after registration. This means that it is extremely important that your child arrives in school on time each day.

## **Being prepared!**

In order to for your child to be as prepared as possible for the tests each day, please make sure that they get a good night's sleep throughout next week.



Having breakfast every day is equally important. We would like to invite all Y6 children to join us at 8.15am Monday to Thursday next week for breakfast if they wish to do so. Please complete the attached slip to indicate if your child would like breakfast at school during SATS week on any or all of the days. Please complete and return the slip as soon as possible so that we can cater for the expected number of children.



**If your child prefers to have breakfast at home, please make sure they arrive at school promptly from 8.40am each day.**

The results of the tests will be in school from late July and a summary of your child's results will be sent home as soon as we have all data available to us.

All of the children have received lots of additional teaching support focussed on their specific learning needs this year. They have also worked extremely hard to get themselves ready for these tests. This is now their opportunity to demonstrate how much they have learned and the good progress they have all made.
