E-safety support for parents and pupils

Y1 to Y6 class workshops - Thursday 22nd October 2015



Further to my recent newsletter, I would like to remind you about the opportunity to join your child's between **2.15pm and 3pm for an e-safety workshop this Thursday 22nd October 2015.**

On-going changes in modern technology and the potential of the use of the internet by children is really exciting and can be really positive for them. However, it also presents a number of risks and can lead to children not always making the best choices in their use of the internet and often, in particular, social networking sites.

These risks are at their greatest for children at home as these opportunities do not present themselves in school. However, we recognise that supporting your child to keep safe when using the internet is a significant challenge for parents and we are very keen to provide as much support as we can with e-safety advice and guidance.

Your child is learning about e-safety as part of their computing curriculum and each class from Y1 to Y6 is currently planning a session for parents linked to an aspect of e-safety that they have been learning about. They are all excited to share what they have learnt with you and this is a very valuable opportunity for you to find out from your child/children and their teachers, how you can help them to keep safe on-line. The children have all worked very hard to prepare for Thursday and I do hope that you will support them by attending the workshops.

In order for us to plan for Thursday, I would be grateful if you could complete the attached slip and return it to your child's class teacher as soon as possible to confirm your attendance. I look forward to welcoming you on Thursday. Please arrive at the main entrance shortly before 2.30pm on the day. **A polite reminder that these sessions are not suitable for pre-school children as you will be visiting classes during their lesson time.**
