Performing Arts – Thursday 4th and Friday 5th August - 8.30am to 4pm

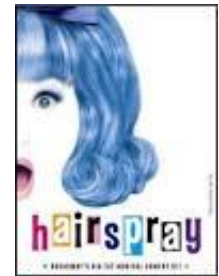
Come and join Premier Performing Arts this summer! Back with our 'Mini Musicals in a Day!' this time for two days of Performing Arts fun!

This summer the children can participate in two new musicals with professionally trained instructors who will deliver dance, drama and singing sessions.

Day one will be a ' Wizard of Oz' theme, learning the scenes and dances to help Dorothy find the Wizard of Oz down the yellow brick road!



The second day the children will participate in a 'Hairspray' Musical in a day, learning all the upbeat songs and dances from the popular 60s themed West End show. Along with the Performing Arts activities, the children will take part in a prop making session linked to the days show- there is something for everyone!



The children will work towards a performance which the parents/guardians will be invited to watch 15 minutes prior to pick up time where there will also be a presentation of certificates and awards from the day.

Children should bring a water bottle and packed lunch for the day as ensue they are wearing comfortable clothing to move around in. If they are participating in the 'Hairspray' day a bright coloured top to wear would be great to add to the costume but not essential.
