We all know that it can sometimes be challenging to keep up to speed with what children and young people are doing online. If you attend one of the workshops next week, you will be offered lots of useful ways to help keep your child safe.

The E-safety workshops will be led by a qualified ICT consultant, Mr John Jeffries.

The first workshop will run from **10am to 11am** after the open morning session and the second workshop will run from **2pm to 3pm** after the open afternoon session.
