School Meal Provision for YR to Y6 – New Menu 2nd November onwards

Dear Parents

I am pleased to enclose our new school meal menu for next term.

We are very pleased with the quality of our meal provision from the new provider we appointed from September and if your child does not currently have school lunches, we would strongly encourage you to consider the enclosed menu with your child/children.



If your child is entitled to a free meal, either through the government scheme for YR to Y2 or through free school meal eligibility, we will order a main meal each day for your child unless you complete the order form to indicate another choice. If your child will not be eating these meals please let us know to avoid any unnecessary waste. The government estimate that a free meal will save families approximately £400 per child per year as you will not have to pay for a school meal or provide a packed lunch. This is a significant amount of money and we highly recommend that you do take advantage of the free meals for your child/children.

Y3 to Y6

Attached is the new menu for next term. The 'Meal Deal' is **£2.30** (for children in years 3 - 6) and is a really economical option, with a main meal, vegetables, pudding and a drink. You are able to complete the order form (and pay) for the whole term or just one week as you wish and there is an option to have either a main meal or a jacket potato. **Please return any completed order forms for the week commencing 2nd November by this Wednesday 21st October 2015.**





Finally, we will be celebrating **National School Meals Week** which takes place between 2nd November and 6th November 2015.

To celebrate this event, we will be holding a Roast Dinner Day on Wednesday 4th November 2015. Roast Dinner Day is Food for Life's annual celebration of the fantastic cooks and caterers who serve daily nutritious and fresh school dinners for our children and this is an excellent opportunity for your child/children to enjoy a delicious roast dinner with their friends and teachers.
